languid	weak or faint from illness or fatigue
quarried	extract (stone or other materials) from the ground.
brooch	an ornament fastened to clothing with a hinged pin and catch.
updraft	an upward current or draft of air.
Discarded dissever	get rid of divide or sever
lichens	a simple slow-growing plant that typically forms a low crustlike, leaflike, or branching growth on rocks, walls, and trees
grappling	a small anchor; engage in a close fight or struggle
saguaro	a giant cactus that can grow to 66 feet
masons	a builder and worker in stone.
seraphs	an angelic being, regarded in traditional Christian angelology
coveted	yearn to possess or have (something)
sepulcher	a small room or monument, cut in rock or built of stone, in which a dead person is laid or buried
